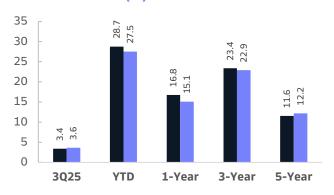

Index Performance (%)



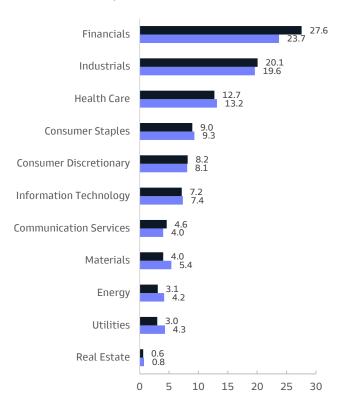

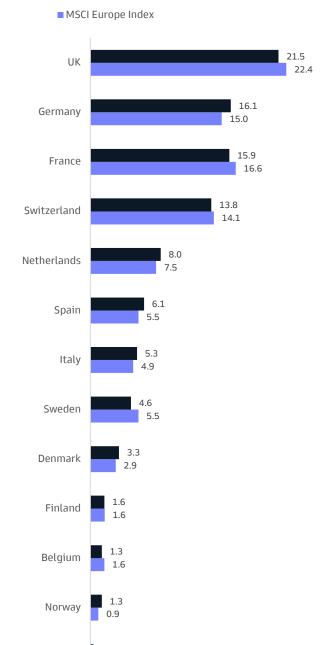
